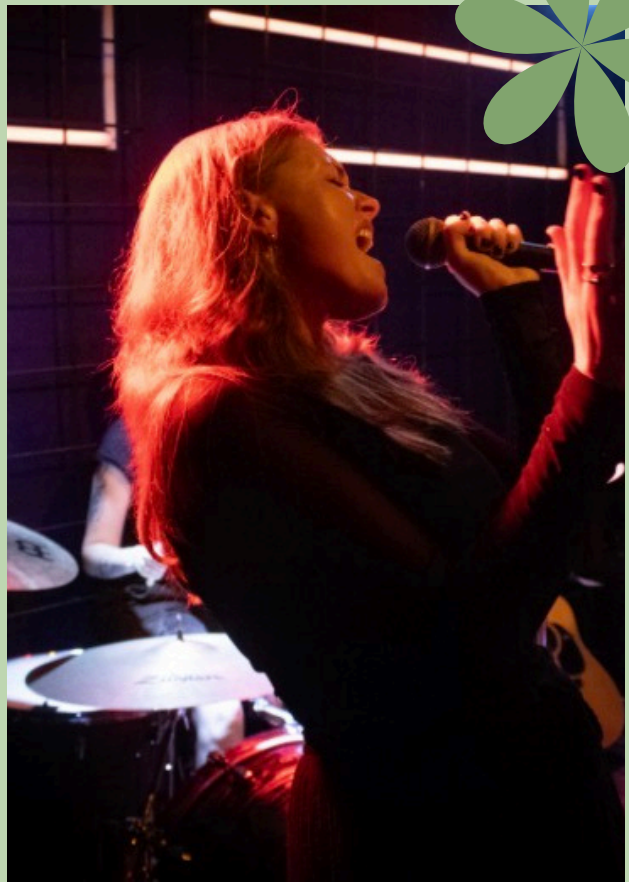

Explore genres
