Biological and Physical Uniqueness

- **Vocal Fold Structure:** Differences in the size and mass of the vocal folds (vocal cords) dictate the natural range and tone of a voice.
- **Resonance Chambers:** The unique shape and size of an individual's sinuses, throat, and mouth act as an amplifier, creating a one-of-a-kind tone (timbre).
- **Body Proportions:** Vocal strength is often supported by the strength of the diaphragm and overall physical capacity to produce power.
