Choosing what type of singer to be involves a blend of self-awareness, vocal ability, and career aspirations. Key factors to consider include your natural vocal characteristics (range, weight, timbre), the musical genres you are passionate about, and your goals regarding performance vs. studio work.

LET'S START SIMPLE...

- **Vocal Type and Range:** Are you a soprano, mezzo, alto, tenor, baritone, or bass?
- **Tessitura:** This is the range where your voice feels most comfortable and sounds best, which is often more important than your absolute highest or lowest notes.
- **Timbre (Tonal Quality):** Does your voice sound bright, dark, light, heavy, husky, or airy?
- **Bridge Location (Passaggio):** Where your voice transitions between registers (e.g., chest voice to head voice) affects your natural style
