STEP INTO THE NEW SEASON IN STYLE

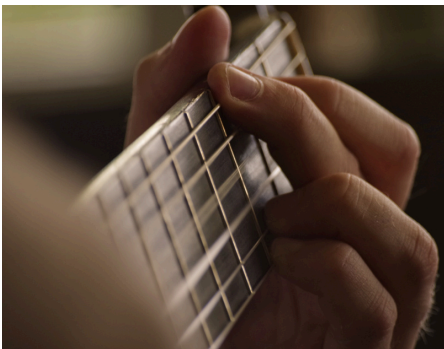
